

STATEMENT OF WORK (SOW)

Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA)

Charlotte County Airport Staging Area AA Batteries and Weather Radios with Vibrator and Strobe

Requirement:

FEMA has a requirement for 500 (Five Hundred) Midland Alert Weather Radios with Vibrator and Strobe to include 63 (Sixty-Three) – 24 Pack AA Batteries. These weather radios will help protect citizens by providing notification of severe weather events in their area. The shaker and strobe attached to the weather radio device is for ADA compliance. The radios will be placed in FEMA travel trailer dispatchers to support the Direct Housing mission of DR-4673-FL. Each Weather Radio shall have the following specifications:

FEATURES AND SPECIFICATIONS:

- High-performance receiver monitors U.S. Emergency All Hazards, and Emergency Alert System (EAS) weather bulletins, warnings, and forecasts
- Receives all National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) reports, which provides all available emergency advisories on tornadoes, severe thunderstorms, floods, evacuations, civil danger warnings, and more
- Flexible programming— select SAME broadcasts in up to 25 counties
- Clock displays time and has alarm and snooze functions
- Telescopic antenna provides maximum range reception up to 50 miles
- Antenna folds down for easy transport
- External power jack allows use of AC adapter (included) or DC cigarette lighter power cord (optional) to run off a car or boat battery
- Battery backup uses 3 AA alkaline batteries
- External alert jack allows use of other alerting devices (see Related Products below)
- LED-backlit display
- Low battery level indicator
- Dimensions: 5.5" x 2.0" x 6.0" (130mm x 50mm x 152mm)

STROBE (X67-S):

The Strobe accessory gives you a reliable visual notification when your weather radio receives important weather and hazard alerts.

VIBRATOR (X67-V):

The Vibrator accessory to your Midland Alert Weather Radio gives you a reliable vibrating notification when your weather radio receives important weather and hazard alerts.

Each weather radio will require 3 AA batteries.
