SUBJECT: Brand Name Exact Match Memo for Unison Buy # 1121409

1. The 99th RD is initiating life cycle replacement of current lifting devices and shop equipment in our maintenance activities. We request that this be allowed to be purchased to provide continuity with existing on-hand assets. Additionally, United States Army Reserve Command has authorized staffing levels to be filled at 110% of the authorized qty listed on the TDA. This increase in staffing has increased the mission and qty of technicians at our maintenance shops, requiring additional shop tools to support them.
2. Brand-named items provide consistency amongst 48 shops and approximately 700 employees. Keeping consistent and relative equipment provides ease of use and familiarity, reducing workplace accidents.
3. In addition, employees can travel from shop to shop and understand how to operate the equipment without time loss. This flexibility allows a more versatile workforce giving decision-makers better options for becoming more efficient in completing real-world missions.
4. For the reasons listed above, the, 99th Readiness Division G4 Directorate of Logistics requests brand name purchase of the ARI-HETRA WS-18-HR Brake Hub Removal Jack, ARI HETRA TT-2000 Lifting Table, and ARI HETRA AH-4000 Transmission Jack.
