

52.212-2 Evaluation – COMMERCIAL PRODUCTS AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES
(Nov 2021)

(a) The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate offers:

Evaluations will be based on specifications provided by requiring activity and supporting documents provided by industry. Supporting documents shall be meet or exceed/Lowest price technically acceptable quote.

Interested parties shall submit product samples in order to be considered for award by the **closing date of January 24, 2023 no later than 12 pm. Eastern Time.**

(b) Evaluation Criteria. *Product samples.* one (1) Garment Bag is required at or prior to the time specified for receipt of offers (see 52.212-1 Addendum). This sample shall be submitted at no expense to the Government. Samples will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria listed below. Evaluation criteria consists of factors. The quote will be evaluated under TWO (2) evaluation factors: Sample and Price.

The award will be made to the lowest priced technically acceptable quote/proposal. Quotes/Proposals will be evaluated for technical acceptability but will not be ranked using the non-price Factors (and Subfactors). In order for an Offeror to be considered for award, the quote/proposal must receive an "Acceptable" rating in every non-price Factor. A quote/proposal receiving a rating of "Unacceptable" in any non-price Factor will not be eligible for award.

Factor 1 – Sample. The Sample will receive a rating defined below.

TECHNICAL ACCEPTABLE/UNACCEPTABLE RATINGS

Rating	Definition
Acceptable	Proposal meets the requirements of the solicitation.
Unacceptable	Proposal does not meet the requirements of the solicitation.

In order to receive an acceptable rating, the sample submissions must not have more than One (1) Major defect in sample, or Three (3) Minor defects equals one (1) Major defect in sample as stated in the evaluation criteria listed below.

Factor 2 – Price. Price will be scored or rated. Evaluation of price will be performed using one or more of the price analysis techniques in FAR 13.106-3(a). Through these techniques the Government will determine whether prices are reasonable.

IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED FOR AWARD, A SAMPLE MUST BE RECEIVED. THE SAMPLE UNIT OF A GARMENT BAG MUST BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE THE closing date of January 24, 2023 no later than 12 pm. Eastern Time.

Defects

(1) Major Defect in the sample will fail the sample and it shall be considered unacceptable to the Government.

(3) Minor Defects in the sample will fail the sample and it shall be considered unacceptable to the Government.

Samples will be evaluated in accordance with the evaluation criteria stated below:
