

JOINT BASE LEWIS-MCCHORD (JBLM) AIR SHOW SMOKE OIL

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this purchase order is to fulfill the need of Smoke Oil for the 2023 Joint Base Lewis-McChord Joint Airshow and Warrior Expo. This year's Air Show will be held July 15-16. The Smoke Oil shall be delivered no later than July 12, 2023.

2.0 REQUIREMENTS

The objective of this purchase order is to provide Smoke Oil for the 2023 Joint Base Lewis-McChord Joint Airshow and Warrior Expo. Vendor shall deliver Smoke Oil no later than July 12, 2023.

2.1 Significant Characteristics - Smoke Oil requirements. The Vendor shall meet or surpass all of the following requirements:

2.1.1 Deliver Smoke Oil no later than July 12, 2023.

2.1.2 Quantity – 30 Each - 55 Gallon Drums.

2.1.3 The following are acceptable Smoke Oil types. Only one type is needed to fulfill the requirement:

- a. Chevron U.S.A., Inc Canopus 13 04BH0
- b. Shell Oil Company Aeroshell Smoke Oil 5W416
- c. Copper State Petrol. CSP Aviation Smoke Oil 6TAZ7
- d. W.S. Dodge Oil Company Smoke Oil C13 0XAK2
- e. PetroBlend Corporation Pure White Smoke Oil 7G4W2
- f. Petro-Canada Paraflex HT10 Fluids 0NVS1
- g. Phillips 66 Company Los Angeles, CA, Aviation Smoke Oil, 883E7

2.1.4 Smoke oil drums shall be placed and kept on pallets (2 - 4 per pallet) and positioned near Building J-23 McCarthy Blvd, Joint Base Lewis-McChord, WA, 98438. Only full, unopened containers are acceptable.

2.1.5 Unused and unopened 55-gallon barrels of smoke oil may be returned at no additional cost for a full refund, after the completion of the 2023 Joint Base Lewis-McChord Joint Airshow and Warrior Expo.

The items will be inspected by using visual inspection for quality and defect. Any defects or issues detected will be communicated back to the supplier/OEM for replacement and/or repair IAW the company's and FAR warranty clause.

The Vendor shall provide the timely delivery of goods and services. Quality of all services or supplies provided shall conform at least to commercial standards in the relevant profession, trade, or field of endeavor.
