

## RFI Description - Online Civil Engineering Training

Purpose: The Coast Guard is issuing this request for information (RFI) for market research purposes to identify sources capable of providing professional development training courses for engineers and architects in the Coast Guard Civil Engineering Program. The skills needed for design/construction projects and career development. A library of 1000+ training courses shall be available 24/7; individual users shall have unlimited training courses for one year. The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) Civil Engineering community manages the planning, design, construction, contingency engineering, real property, environmental, and public works support for the USCG shore facilities.

The applicable North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code assigned to this procurement may be NAICS Code: 611430 (Professional and Management Development Training).
