The primary North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) code applicable to this notice has been determined to be 112990 for small business set-aside.

ACQUISITION INFORMATION

This Request for Quote (RFQ) is solicited under FAR Part 12 and 13.

SCOPE

The Offeror shall be responsible for providing required canines, on an individual order basis, to the appropriate CBP Canine Center. All canines shall meet the acceptance criteria contained in the Statement of Work.

I.2 52.212-2 EVALUATION--COMMERCIAL ITEMS (OCT 2014)

- (a) The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the solicitation with the lowest price, technically acceptable, and with a minimum Neutral rating in past performance. The following factors shall be used to evaluate offers:

Technical, past performance, and price.

Technical Acceptability will be determined by the Offeror meeting the minimum requirements set forth in the SOW.

Past Performance: The Government will conduct a past performance evaluation. The past performance evaluator(s) shall consider any data available in federal procurement databases such as the System for Award Management (SAM), Federal Awardee Performance and Integrity Information System (FAPIS) and the Contractor's Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS) and any relevant information found outside these systems, either through knowledge of the Contracting Officer or other individuals who have worked with the Offeror in the past for requirements.

Favorable rating is determined, as the offeror's performance has no active exclusions, has a current SAM account, and has no negative findings on the FAPIS report, nor any outstanding orders.

Neutral rating is determined as no past performance found.
