

## COMBINED SYNOPSIS/SOLICITATION 70Z02323Q00920001

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial products prepared in accordance with the format in Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.

This RFQ is Set-Aside (100%) for Small Business Concerns. The North American Industry Classification (NAICS) is 334310 – Audio and Video Equipment Manufacturing and the size standard is 750 employees.

This requirement is to procure one (1) *Rupert Neve Designs (RND) 5088* 16-Channel Audio Mixing Console with eight (8) Stereo Channel Modules. This RFQ contains a brand name or equal description. In accordance with FAR 6.302-1(c)(2), vendors may offer products other than those specifically referenced by brand-name if those products meet all salient characteristics provided in attachment 1.

Date of delivery is: 30 days from the date that the purchase order is issued.

All prices submitted in response to this solicitation shall be based on firm fixed prices. Quotations shall include unit prices, extended prices and total price in a format similar to the above table. This solicitation will result in one purchase order which will be awarded to the

small business offering the requisite supplies within the stated delivery time and at the lowest price.

The provision at 52.212-1, Instructions to Offerors – Commercial Products and Commercial Services, applies to this procurement.

The provision at 52.212-2, Evaluation - Commercial Products and Commercial Services does not apply to this RFQ.

A written notice of award or acceptance of an offer, mailed or otherwise furnished to the successful offeror with the time for acceptance specified in the offer, shall result in a binding contract without further action by either party.

Offerors shall comply with the provision at 52.212-3, Offeror Representations and Certifications - Commercial Products and Commercial Services – which is incorporated by reference – and include a completed copy with their offers.
