This is a Combined Synopsis/Solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in FAR Subpart 12.6, Acquisition of Commercial Items and FAR Part 13, Simplified Acquisition Procedures, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; proposals and a written solicitation will not be issues.

5. **Description of Requirements:** The **United States Coast Guard Training Center Petaluma (USCG TCP) located at 599 Tomales Road, Bldg. 530 Petaluma, CA 94952** has a requirement for the following: **Contractor to deliver Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) as indicated in the Scope of Work.**

The U.S. Coast Guard is responsible for managing the training, education, and development of programs to meet the needs of its active duty, reserve, and civilian workforce. The purpose of this Combined Synopsis/Solicitation is to obtain the required supplies and services for the **United States Coast Guard Training Center Petaluma (USCG TCP) located at 599 Tomales Road, Petaluma, CA 94952** and provide highly proficient training to all required USCG personnel as directed by FORCECOM, CG-721, CG-731, and the Coast Guard Maritime Security (Counterterrorism) Division (CG-DOD-2).

Purchase description: Contractor to deliver Liquid Petroleum Gas (LPG) as indicated in the Scope of Work.

6. Anticipated award will be made **within 2 days after** solicitation closes.

Responsibility and Inspection: Unless otherwise specified in the contract or purchase order, the supplier is responsible for the performance of all inspection requirements and Quality Control (QC). The contractor shall coordinate the exact dates and times of delivery with the Reclamation, at least one week in advance. The contractor shall ensure that the total for all amounts ordered and delivered does not exceed the amount noted in the contract line items.

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All quotes shall include one (1) separate copy of each of the items listed below. Submission of a quote that does not contain all items requested below may result in elimination from consideration of award. Offerors are responsible for including sufficient details to permit a complete and accurate evaluation of each quote.

8. The Government will award a **Firm-Fixed Price** contract resulting from this combined synopsis/solicitation to the responsible offeror whose offer conforming to the synopsis/solicitation will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered.

Best Value

Award Criteria - Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) in accordance with FAR Part 13.106-2 Evaluation of quotations. Awards will be made to the acceptable quoters with the lowest evaluated price, which is deemed responsible in accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation and whose proposals meet all required terms and conditions, meet all technical requirements, conform to, and include all required certifications. The Government reserves the right to award without discussions, therefore, each initial offer should contain the offeror's best terms from a price and technical standpoint. However, the Government reserves the right to conduct discussions if determined necessary by the Contracting Officer.

Number of Contracts to be Awarded: The Government intends to select one contractor to provide the services covered herein. However, the Government reserves the right to award no contract at all, depending on the quality of the proposals and prices submitted and the availability of funds.

Rejection of Unrealistic Offers: The Government may reject any proposal that is evaluated to be unrealistic in terms of program commitments, including contract terms and conditions, or unrealistically high or low in price when compared to Government estimates, such that the proposal is deemed to reflect an inherent lack of competence or failure to comprehend the complexity and risks of the program.

Solicitation Requirements, Terms and Conditions: Offerors are required to meet all solicitation requirements, such as terms and conditions, representations and certifications, and technical requirements detailed in the **SOW**, in addition to those identified as evaluation factors or subfactors. Failure to meet a requirement may result in an offer being ineligible for award. Offerors must clearly identify any exception to the solicitation terms and conditions and provide complete accompanying rationale.
