All Venders shall submit photos are for "Reference Only" and specifications on your UTV product, along with your RFQ if you wish to be considered. Also you need comply with Buy American Act - state country of origin.)

1. The below listed specifications are the minimum requirments for a UTV purchase for the West Point Fire and Emergency Services. Price quotes should inclue all minimum items and include delivery to Fire Station 2, 1203 Stony Lonesome Road, West Point, NY 10996.



2. Power plant: 999 CC or Larger 4 Stroke Gas Engine  
80 HP or Greater  
Cooling system: Liquid  
Fuel System: Electronic Fuel injection

Drive train:

Automatic with High, Low range

2wd, with AWD or 4 wheel drive selection

Suspension:

Equal to or greater than 11" of travel in both front and rear suspension systems

Braking:

4 wheel disc hydraulic brakes

Parking brake

Tires:

27 x 9-12 or larger for all 4 wheels.

Wheelbase: 70" or larger

Dry weight: 1000 lbs or greater

Ground Clearance: 13" or greater

Seating Capacity: 2

Fuel capacity 9 US gal or larger

Rear Bed Box Dimensions:

32" X 42" X 11" or larger in size

36 x 54 x 12 (plus a tiny bit more)

Payload capacity: 1000 lbs. or greater (based on the weight of the skid unit being 900 when fully loaded)

Hitch towing: 1500 lb or greater

Hitch: Standard 2" receiver

Lighting: 50 W headlights or brighter, LED taillights

Electronic Power steering

Instrumentation:

Information center display, Speedometer, tachometer, odometer, trip meter, clock, hour meter, gear indicator, fuel gauge, coolant temperature, voltmeter, service indicator, mechanical codes, DC outlet plug

Cab:

Roll over protection system

Windshield – POLY

Driver and passenger doors

Rear window (fully enclosed cab when everything is shut)

10 inch or greater roof mounted LED light bar

Busbar Harness

3,500 or greater capacity bumper mounted winch kit

Light bar harness
